The Town board discussed the problem of Chad Pelkey not showing up for work, or showing up late at the landfill. Darin Forbes said John Langford said he did the same thing last summer, but he didn't say anything because he was a temporary employee. He wasn't showing up or he was late. He has no confidence in him for ever coming back and being a summer helper and now he is doing it at the dump. Why prolong the agony because in another week he will do it again. Darin is getting complaints from people that load up their car and the dump not open and they have to take the garbage home. Why keep giving people chances, we need someone that is reliable. He has been here three weeks and called in twice and been late other days. I don't see it working, I think we are just avoiding the inevitable. Rarilee said would Doug be willing to work part time now until more work opens up in the Spring. Supervisor- I think he would do anything to get his foot in the door. We had to let Cecil go for not showing up for work. Doug told the supervisor that if he is hired he would have to give two weeks notice.
