Bethany Kress and Steve Forbes were the only people that signed in. Also present were Danielle Celenzo, Amy Langford, and Tony Nickinello. Nicole Forbes, the Secretary to the Supervisor and Accounts Clerk was asked to attend the meeting to explain financial questions from the youth group.

Discussions

Supervisor Holzer discussed the reasons why the BTI was not as effective as normal. He explained that when he inquired about this with the company, they stated that it was because of the abnormal winter and spring we experienced.

Supervisor Holzer stated he was filling out the Mining Permit Renewal for the former landfill and that we are moving forward with the final closing of the area. All clean fills will be used to start this process.

The Town Board Meeting for June will be held on the 20th instead of its normal date.

The Town is looking for additional grants for the Homestead Housing Project. We are hoping to have a groundbreaking Mid to Late summer.

The Town Board is looking at the final numbers for the improvements to the Highway garage now that all the insurance payments have been received.

Wilmington Town Beach will open the last week in June. The dock will not be able to be put out unless we are able to find additional lifeguards.

An additional five benches have been ordered as discussed at the last meeting.

The new speed light will be going on Bonnieview Road. Only one of the two approved have been ordered. Parts for the old sign have been ordered.

A discussion was had on the very bad cellphone service in the area, it seems to be getting worse instead of better.

A lengthy discussion was had between the Youth Group and the Board. Nicole Forbes explained procedures that must be followed for their town account. They asked many questions and now have a better understanding of the procedures. They will now receive a monthly statement of the account and will itemize their expenditures and earnings.
