As part of our projects this year, we have purchased 5 new park benches to be placed throughout Wilmington. Funded through the Community Enhancement Fund, which is funds generated from the commonly known "Occupancy or Bed Tax", two of the benches will be placed on the side of the recreational path on both Springfield and Fox Farm Roads. Benches will also be added to the town park.
