

NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF TENTATIVE ASSESSMENT ROLL

(Notice of completion shall be published once in the official newspaper of the town and a copy of the published notice posted on the signboard at the entrance of the town clerk's office stating that the assessor(s) have completed the tentative roll, where the roll may be examined and when and where Grievance Day will held (RPTL, §§ 506, 526(1), 1526). Note: this part does not have to be included in the newspaper, it is instructional only.

Legal for newspaper:

Notice is hereby given that the Assessors of the Town of Wilmington, County of Essex, have completed the Tentative Assessment Roll for the current year and that a copy has been left with Town Clerk at Town Hall, where it may be seen and examined by any interested person until the fourth Tuesday in May (or other applicable date).
